Foy Vance is a singer from Belfast who has been hailed by Bonnie Raitt as “... one of the most soulful and powerful singers and writers I’ve heard in a long time”.

Steve Jones is a guitarist and songwriter who has worked with Brian Eno, Ronan Keating and Brendan Perry, and most recently cult French band Air.

David Tughan is a jazz singer considered by the Observer to be “the epitome of cool”. Firmly in the Chet Baker tradition he has, according to *All About Jazz*, “Frank Sinatra’s phrasing and a delivery all his own”.

Frances Thornburn has been described as the missing link between Karen Carpenter and Björk. Most recently she has been starring in the West End production of *Fiddler on the Roof*.

Scott Smith is from Wichita, Kansas but has been delighting audiences in the UK since the mid-nineties, mining a rich seam of bluegrass and Americana.
